

Special Equestrians COVID – 19 Phased Reopening Plan

SE Phase 1 – 5/2/2020 – June 6/2020

- Essential Staff and volunteers on property on set days and times
- Conditioning the Horses by Instructors, Exercise Riders and Horse Handlers
- Individual Helmets (rider owned) are required
- Social distancing, Masks, Hand washing or sanitizing required
- SE is closed for visitors

SE Phase 2 – 6/9/2020 – 6/27/2020

- SE initial limited opening for participants, 2 per class
- Participants must an independent rider or need horse leader only
- Participants must be independent in mounting, dismounting
- Individual Helmets (rider owned) are required
- Social distancing, masks, hand washing, or sanitizing required
- SE is closed for visitors

SE Phase 3 – Summer Break, 2020

- SE Group Classes Break
- Virtual Education offered to present participants
- Most Volunteer training will be done virtually at this time
- Volunteer Training for public (limited availability)
- Volunteer Training for parents and caregivers of riders
- Social distancing, masks, hand washing, or sanitizing required
- SE is closed for visitors

SE Phase 4 – Fall, September 29, 2020

- Therapeutic Riding Classes reopen for the Fall 2020 session
- Participants needing support volunteers will use parents & caregivers, who are trained volunteers
- Continue Disinfecting and Sanitizing in all Areas
- Most Volunteer training will be done virtually at this time
- Individual Helmets (rider owned) are required
- Social distancing, masks, hand washing, or sanitizing required
- SE may be open for visitors by appointment only
- Phase 4 dates will depend on current CDC and Florida state guidelines for reopening

SE Phase 5 – Date to be determined

- Therapeutic riding classes continue
- Veterans, Carriage Driving Classes resume
- Depending on Social Distancing Guidelines, All Riders & Full Volunteer Support
- Individual Helmets (rider owned) are required
- Social distancing, masks, hand washing, or sanitizing, according to CDC guidelines
- Continue Disinfecting and Sanitizing in all Areas
- Special Equestrians open for visitors
- Phase 5 plans are tentative and subject to change, depending on current CDC and Florida state guidelines for reopening
